

# Bursary for Air Traffic Safety Electronic Personnel (ATSEP)

## Role Overview

ATSEP comprise of engineers, technicians, and computer hardware and software specialists who are responsible for the specification, procurement, installation, calibration, maintenance, testing and certification of ground electronic systems used for providing air traffic control and navigation services to aircraft operating in Namibia. The successful applicant will conduct ongoing inspection, maintenance and support routines for all Communication, Navigation and Surveillance (CNS) equipment for Air Navigation Services (ANS) at and around duty stations and equipment sites throughout Namibia. Once a bursar has successfully completed the training programme, the person will be obliged to work for the NCAA, should the NCAA make an offer of employment in terms of the Bursary Agreement.

## Job Objectives

- Inspection, maintenance and support routines of CNS equipment.
- Ensure compliance with aviation regulations.
- Deliver according to budget.
- Deliver customer services according to the required standards.
- Deliver on performance and training and development initiatives.

## Minimum Requirements

Applicants must:

- Be a minimum of 21 years old.
- Passed Namibian National Senior Secondary Certificate (NSSC)/Grade 12 (Ordinary Level) with at least 25 Admission Points, at least Grade C for Mathematics and English and no grade less than Grade D for the three highest graded subjects excluding Mathematics and English.
- Be a Namibian citizen.
- Have a valid drivers' license.
- Be willing to undergo psychometric assessments; security, criminal record and credit checks, and medical examinations.

## Education Requirements

- Grade 12 certificate with English & Mathematics.
- Diploma or Bachelor of Engineering qualification in Electronics or equivalent NQF7 qualification.
