**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PUBLISH NCAA ENFORCEMENT CODE**

Please take note that the Interim Executive Director of the NCAA intends to publish for issue, an Enforcement Code for the Namibia Civil Aviation System pursuant to sections 10 (1) (b) and 38(2)(b) of the Civil Aviation Act of 2016 (Act no. 6 of 2016), and in accordance with Part 13.01.1(2) of the Namibia Civil Aviation Regulations, 2001 (as amended in 2018; hereinafter “the NAMCARS”). Thus, with a view thereto, the NCAA seeks to obtain the comments and views from the public or any interested person (including aviation document holders/participants/owners) on the released draft of the Enforcement Code.

The comments sought in this connection are required in compliance with the NAMCARS, in particular as in Part 3.04.3 thereof. A period of at least 30 days from the date of this notice will be available for submission of comments (at the latest by 4<sup>th</sup> September 2019).
